

LIGHTING REQUEST APPLICATION FOR PARLIAMENT HOUSE NORTH TERRACE, ADELAIDE

Parliament House and the Presiding Officers are actively committed to engaging with the community on issues of public interest. One way Parliament does this is by providing community groups with the opportunity to request, through the Joint Presiding Officers, the lighting of Parliament to promote a community initiative.

On approval, Parliament House will light the northern and eastern façade facing Adelaide city. The public will be advised of the lighting of Parliament House and the cause it promotes via the Parliament website and related social media. Please note light/pastel colours are not as easily visible. A maximum of a one day period can be requested (multiple days may be considered in special circumstances).

Applications should be made a minimum of 14 days prior to the date of promotion to avoid scheduling conflicts.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The cause is apolitical in nature
- 2. Advertising regarding the lighting of Parliament in relation to the cause maintains the dignity of the Parliament
- 3. The cause has significant community interest or benefit
- 4. The cause is not related to a National Day or an Independence Day of a particular nation
